Manufacturing

Acme is growing their manufacturing industry within the Village. New to the community is a multiphased food production operation which began operation of the first phase in 2025 with plans to complete the next phases in the near future. In addition to these new manufacturing operations, the surrounding area also provides meat processing and greenhouse operations for the local food industry.



Transportation

While public transportation options are limited, agriculture-related logistics and services are key to the area's transportation needs. Located a few kilometers north of Highway 9 and between Highways 2 and 21, Acme is an ideal location for agricultural transportation services. Acme is home to two trucking operations specializing is livestock, general freight, and liquid gases.



Agriculture

Agriculture plays a significant role in the local economy and lifestyle in Acme, with farming being the primary industry in the region. The agricultural landscape of the surrounding areas is characterized by expansive open fields, with climate and soil conditions that are conducive to agriculture. There is a mixture of farming in the area including grain, beef, and hog operations.
